### LONGYARD GOLF TWILIGHT SEASON

### **ENTRY**

- Registration fee is \$50.00 per team, and must be paid in full with entry form. 100% of the registration will go towards Ronald McDonald House Tamworth.
- Registration forms are to be submitted by Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> October 2017. Substitute players will only be permitted if the team member replaced has not completed any competition rounds.
- Weekly fees are \$17.00. This will include a \$1 donation from each player to Ronald McDonald House Tamworth plus a weekly ball comp.

### **RONALD MCDONALD HOUSE TAMWORTH DONATION**

- 100% team registration will be donated.
- 100% sponsorship will be donated.
- \$1 per twilight round played will be donated.

### **CONDITIONS OF PLAY**

- Each team can consist of 10 players and may include any combination of golfers & non-golfers.
- Men will tee off the YELLOW markers. Ladies will tee off from the RED or YELLOW markers depending on which are closest to the Fairway on every hole.
- Team members can enter more than once per week for the weekly individual comp.
- The Team's weekly score will comprise the best 6 stableford scores.
- Stableford scoring is used by each player.
- Players can play on any day, subject to course availability, but must play with at least one other person to mark their score card. I.e. Players do not have to physically play with a person from their own or opposing team.
- Score cards must be returned on the same day in which they are played or will be declared disqualified and they must be on a Longyard Scorecard.
- Preferred lies through the green. (1 Card Length)
- Players won't be allowed to play their Twilight round in conjunction with a Club Competition.

#### **PRIZES**

- Twilight Minor Premiers and Runners-Up will both receive a \$50 Windmill Tavern/Longyard Pro Shop Voucher each.
- The team that wins the Final will also receive a \$75 Windmill Tavern/Longyard Pro Shop Voucher each.

### **HANDICAPS**

- Players to commence the competition with their current golf
   Australia Handicap. If they do not have an AGU handicap they
   should use the handicap allocated from last years competition.
   New players will be handicapped on their first 9 hole card (Note:
   These players must record their stroke score for this round).
- Handicap limits are: Male 36; Female 54.
- Players scoring 20 points or more will lose handicap strokes as follows: 20pts = -1, 21 = -2, 22 = -3 and so on.
- Players scoring 13 or less will get back +1.

#### **FINALS**


- The final will have a total of 8 teams.
- The Top 6 teams as of Monday 19<sup>th</sup> February will progress through to the finals and they will also continue to Play-Off for the Minor Premiers using their accumulative points from the Twilight Season.
- The remaining teams will Play-Off from Monday 19<sup>th</sup> February to Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> March in the Final Dash with these teams starting back at Zero points. This will see all teams outside the Top 6 Play-Off over the last month to make up the remaining 2 spots in the Final.
- To be eligible for the Final Dash all teams must have a total of 70 games played over the twilight Season.
- During the finals series, a count back system will be used to break tied matches. The count back system is used as follows: If teams are tied at the completion of the match the match will be decided by just the best three (3) scores. If still a tie, the best two (2) scores. If still a tie, the best score (1) only. If still a tie, the last six holes of the best score, then the last three holes of the best score, then hole by hole starting from the last hole working backwards.

### PRESENTATION DINNER

 Presentation Dinner will be held after the completion of the final round on Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> March, which will be at each players own expense.

### **TWILIGHT SEASON**

- Starts on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> October 2017 till Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> December 2017. We will have a break over Christmas and Re Start Monday 1<sup>st</sup> January 2018 till Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> March 2018.
- Monday 19<sup>th</sup> February till Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> March will be the Play-Off period for the Minor Premiers and the Final Dash.
- Final to be played on Saturday 24th March 2018.
